Introduction

Fort Belvoir is an Army post on the Potomac River in Fairfax County, Virginia. It's a large post that's divided into three main areas: the main post, Davidson Army Airfield, and Fort Belvoir North. Settled on land that was once a plantation, and founded during World War I, Fort Belvoir originally served as a training school for the U.S. Army Engineers. Now, nineteen agencies and numerous divisions, battalions, and commands use Fort Belvoir as their operating headquarters.

You'll also find the U.S. Army Prime Power School, a Marine detachment, the U.S. Army Audit Agency, and more. As of the 2010 census, 7,100 people lived in the census designated place that encompasses the post and over 51,000 people worked there.

The Amtrak Auto Station in Lorton, VA is the closest rail station to post. It's a short 15 minute car ride.

Entering Fort Belvoir and Post Amenities

You'll need to provide your military ID for inspection by gate personnel to secure entry into the post. Your spouse and/or children will need a dependent ID card in order to gain access. If you're driving, you'll likely have to show your license and

registration. If you're driving a rental car, then the rental agreement will suffice. If you're visiting for an event or other activity, you'll need to stop by the visitor center and get a pass.

CITIES NEAR FORT BELVOIR

The two biggest cities near Fort Belvoir are Alexandria and Washington, D.C. These are both major U.S. cities with metropolitan areas and plenty of great neighborhoods to settle down in.

BEST PLACES TO LIVE NEAR FORT BELVOIR Washington, D.C.

Washington, D.C. is a majorly historic city filled with over 700,000 people. There are so many things to see and do here, a fact that's affirmed by the close to 25 million tourists who visited in 2019 alone. Jobs are available in all sectors and at every salary range. The industry is booming here, with a GDP of \$141 million. If you see yourself in a bustling metropolitan area, or

neighboring cities. At just a 15minute drive from post, though,
it's hard to beat.

Alexandria

Alexandria is a much smaller city than D.C., with an estimated population of just under 160,000. The historic district of Old Town is home to many cultural centers and entertainment options that'll keep you busy for a long time. The city is full of professionals who work for the government in support or active military roles. You'll find a wealth of neighborhoods with varying price points like Braddock Heights, Rosemont, and the Berg.

Woodbridge

Woodbridge is another censusdesignated place near post, with a huge coast and a natural wildlife preserve. The population of Woodbridge was over 54,000 as of the 2010 census. Inside Woodbridge, you'll find a lot of great shopping, including Potomac Town Centre and Potomac Mills. Home prices are good in this suburban, family friendly area.

Mason Neck

Mason Neck is a small census-designated place on the peninsula of Mason Neck. It takes up just 20 square miles and houses just 2,000 people. Mason Neck is a nature enthusiast's paradise. It's home to wetlands, state parks, and a wide variety of wildlife living alongside the human population. Best of all, it's just a 20-minute drive to post. If rural living is your jam, then this could be the place for you.




Fort Belvoir Weather

The temperature around post is generally moderate, with a hot season that lasts over 3 months and can spike above the 80s. It can get muggy and wet in the summers. In the winter, temperatures are in the 20s and 30s with freezing conditions in the mornings. There's a good amount of cloud coverage yearround, with overcast days becoming relatively common in the winter months. Spring and fall are short, with temperatures declining or inclining into the

following season. It'll be cool for the most part and long sleeves will likely be necessary.

The Villages offer family homes in varying floor plans across 15 unique villages. Check here to input your rank and family size to see which types of floor plans you qualify for. Most homes are between 3-5 bedrooms and 2-3 bathrooms. Single and two-story homes are available which feature single and two-car garages. Town-home style units are also available which features small balconies and parking in a communal lot.

The communities feature lots of <u>amenities</u> such as fitness centers, community gardens, volleyball, tennis, and basketball courts, dog park, swimming pool, event spaces, business center, walking, jogging, and bicycle trails, and access to 24-hour emergency maintenance.

If you have children the <u>primary</u> and <u>upper schools</u> and Child Development Center (CDC) are conveniently located adjacent to The Villages.

1. Belvoir Village

Ranks: 06, 07-010, W5

This village is for senior officers and features 61 historic and five new colonial-style, multi-story houses.

2. Cedar Grove Village

Ranks: 04-05, W3-W4, ADA

Featuring 82 colonial-style four and five-bedroom homes with fenced-in backyards, this village is located near the Fort Belvoir Community Hospital and within walking distance of the Town Centre and playground.

3. Colyer Village

Ranks: E6, E7-E8, O1-O3, O4-O5, W1-W2, W-3-W4, ADA

This village is made up of 72 larger colonial-style four and five-bedroom homes with fenced-in backyards, patios, and two-car garages.

4. Dogue Creek Village

Ranks: E1-E5, E6, E7-E8, E9, O1-O3, O4-O5, O6, O7-O10, W1-W2, W3-W4, W5, ADA

The traditional-style military housing neighborhood features three, four, and five-bedroom brick homes with assigned parking. The area has lovely Potomac River news and lots of mature trees and rich greenery. It is within walking distance of playgrounds, picnic areas, and adjacent to the CYSS Markhams School Age Center.

5. Fairfax Village

Ranks: E9, O4-O5, W3-W4, ADA

101 Colonial-style houses with four and five bedrooms make up this village, six of which are available to E9 families. Homes include a fenced-in backyard, outdoor patio, two-car garages, and has walking trails, a basketball court, and grill stations.

6. Gerber Village

Ranks: E7-E8, E9, O1-O3, O4-O5, O6, W1-W2, W3-W4

Features 75 historic homes in three and four-bedroom duplexes and single-family home configurations. Within walking distance to the Library, Post Office, an indoor pool,

walking trails, picnic area, and basketball court.

7. George Washington Village

Ranks: E1-E5, E6, E7-E8, O1-O3, O4-O5, W1-W2, W-3-W4, ADA

196 Colonial-style three, four, and five-bedroom homes with fenced-in backyards, outdoor patios, and two-car garages make up this village. There is a large neighborhood center with event and meeting rooms, playgrounds, picnic areas, and volleyball and basketball courts.

8. Herryford Village

Ranks: E1-E5, E6, E7-E8, E9, O1-O3, O4-O5, O6, O7-O10, W1-W2, W3-W4, W5, ADA

This village has 171 three, four, and five-bedroom homes in vibrant Colonial-style and features the first Town Center on post which has a Starbucks and Subway as well as shopping. Homes have fenced-in backyards, outdoor patios, and two-car garages. The majority of floor plans in this neighborhood are only available to E1-E5 with a select floor plan open to all other ranks.

9. Jadwin Loop Village

Ranks: O1-O3, O4-O5, W1-W2, W3-W4

This neighborhood has historic, colonial-revival three and four-bedroom homes with spacious porches, two-car garages, and landscaped yards. There are multiple playgrounds, a basketball court, and access to the Fairfax Village Neighborhood Center nearby.

10. Lewis Village

Ranks: E1-E5, E6, E7-E8, E9, O1-O3, O4-O5, W1-W2, W3-W4, ADA

Located next to the Fort Belvoir Primary and Upper Schools, this neighborhood has 274 colonial-style three, four, and five-bedroom homes with fenced-in backyards, outdoor patios, and two-car garages. The Neighborhood Center has a large outdoor pavilion and several playgrounds.

11. Parker Village

Ranks: E9

Featuring 22 craftsman-style homes and two fully restored historic homes, each house has two-car garages, wood-flooring, and a fireplace.

12. River Village

Ranks: E1-E5, E6, E7-E8

186 three-bedroom duplexes with private, fenced-in backyards and front porch

swings make up this neighborhood. Enjoy waterfront views, a playground, basketball court, and a nature garden.

13. Rossell Village

Ranks: O1-O3, O4-O5, W1-W2, W3-W4, ADA

A charming neighborhood with 70 colonial-style four and five-bedroom homes with fenced-in backyards, outdoor patios, and two-car garages. The neighborhood features basketball and volleyball courts, playgrounds, and a picnic area.

14. Vernondale Village

Ranks: E6, E7-E8, O1-O3, W1-W2, ADA

This centrally located neighborhood is made up of 162 colonial-style three, four, and five-bedroom homes with two-car garages, fenced-in backyards, and outdoor patios. The neighborhood amenities include playgrounds, picnic areas, and easy access to shopping and dining at the Town Center.

15. Woodlawn Village

Ranks: E1-E5, E6, E7-E8, E9, O1-O3, O4-O5, W1-W2, W3-W4

Traditional four and fivebedroom homes with attached garages, private, fenced-in backyards, and a state of the art community center with outdoor pool and fitness center, multiple playgrounds, ball courts, dog park, community garden, and biking trail.

FORT BELVOIR WEATHER: WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN MOVING HERE

Introduction

If you're headed to Fort Belvoir, Virginia, you'll find yourself in a humid, subtropical climate with temperate weather. You'll enjoy all four distinct seasons, with hot summers and mild winters. Read on to find out more about the weather at Fort Belvoir, so you can be prepared for any activity, whether it be extensive outdoor training or leisurely evenings spent in your own backyard.

Spring

High temps: High 50s to mid 70s **Low temps**: Mid 30s to mid 50s

Nighttime may feel cool, but spring days at Fort Belvoir are comfortable. Dressing in layers is a great way to adjust to the varying temperatures throughout the day. You may also need an umbrella and a rain jacket for those rainy spring days. And while it may be true that "April showers bring May flowers," you should know that rain falls throughout the year at Fort Belvoir.



Summer

High temps: Mid to high 80s **Low temps**: Low to high 60s

Summers in Virginia are hot and muggy, which can be a tough adjustment if you're not used to the humidity. Thankfully, cooler nights provide relief. Light fabrics and colors can help you stay cool. Don't forget to put on sunscreen, even when there's cloud cover. You can still get sunburned on a cloudy day!

HEAT EXHAUSTION

Because of the area's high summer temperatures, it is important to take precautions to avoid heat exhaustion and heat stroke. If possible, stay indoors when temperatures are extreme. Drink cool liquids often, particularly water, even if you do not feel thirsty. Avoid alcoholic beverages as they dehydrate the body. Eat small, frequent meals and avoid foods high in protein, as they increase metabolic heat.

If you must venture outdoors, avoid going out during midday hours. Avoid strenuous activities and keep hydrated. Heat exhaustion symptoms include heavy sweating; weakness; cold, pale and clammy skin; a fast, weak pulse; nausea or vomiting; and fainting. If you experience symptoms of heat exhaustion,

you should move to a cooler location. Lie down and loosen your clothing, then apply cool, wet cloths to your body. Sip water. If you vomit, seek immediate medical attention. You should also seek out immediate medical attention if you experience symptoms of heat stroke, such as a body temperature of more than 103 degrees; hot, red, dry or moist skin; a rapid and strong pulse; or unconsciousness.

And remember: NEVER leave children or pets alone in closed vehicles.

Fall

High temps: High 50s to low 80s **Low temps**: High 30s to low 60s

Fall at Fort Belvoir is colorful and cool. The leaves put on a vibrant show that you won't want to miss, but by October, you'll be reaching for your jacket when you head out the door. Dress in layers to stay comfortable throughout the day.



Winter

High temps: Mid to high 40s **Low temps**: High 20s to low 30s

Fort Belvoir has mild winters, but you'll likely have a few snow days during your tour here. Warm clothing for cooler winter temperatures will help you stay toasty, even when Jack Frost comes for a visit. Winter jackets, fleece sweaters and pullovers, wool socks, gloves, and tightly knit caps can all help keep heat close. The yearly average snowfall for Fort Belvoir is about 17 inches.

Weather Hazards at Fort Belvoir

THUNDERSTORMS

A severe thunderstorm can knock out power; bring high winds, lightning, flash floods, and hail; and spin into a twister in seconds. Pay attention to storm warnings. Remember the rule: "When thunder roars, head indoors." The National Weather Service recommends following the 30/30 rule: People should seek shelter if the "flash-to-bang" delay — the length of time in seconds from the sight

of the lightning flash to the arrival of its subsequent thunder — is 30 seconds or less, and remain under cover for 30 minutes after the final thunderclap.



FLOODS

Floods are the most common natural disaster in the United States. If you are outdoors during a rainstorm, seek higher ground. Avoid walking through any floodwaters — even water 6 inches deep can sweep you off your feet. If you are driving, avoid flooded areas. The majority of deaths in floods occur when people drive through flooded areas. Roads concealed by water may not be intact. Water only a foot deep can displace a vehicle. If your vehicle stalls, leave it immediately and seek higher ground. Rapidly rising water can engulf a vehicle and sweep it away.

TORNADOES

Tornadoes can happen at any time of the year, but they are most common in spring. Tornadoes can develop quickly, with minimal warning, so it is important to have a plan in

place before they occur. If a tornado watch is issued, that means weather conditions favor the formation of tornadoes, such as during a severe thunderstorm. A tornado warning is issued when a tornado funnel is sighted or indicated by weather radar. You should take shelter immediately during a tornado warning.

WINTER STORMS

Fort Belvoir has mild winters, but winter storms are still possible.

Prepare for winter storms by assembling a disaster supply kit for your home and vehicle. Have your car winterized before the winter storm season arrives. Listen to weather forecasts and plan ahead.

When winter storms and blizzards hit, dangers include strong winds, blinding snow, and frigid wind chills. Avoid unnecessary travel during storm watches and warnings and stay indoors.

Winter storms can also cause power outages. During a power outage, gather in a central room with an alternative heat source. Use fireplaces, wood stoves, and other heaters only if they are properly vented to the outside. Never use an electric generator or a gas or charcoal grill indoors. The fumes are deadly. If you use a space heater, keep the heater away from any object that may

catch fire (drapes, furniture, or bedding) and never leave it unattended. Avoid letting pipes freeze and rupture by leaving faucets slightly open so they drip continuously.




Field & Training Expectations

From hot summer days to cold winter nights, Fort Belvoir experiences a wide range of weather. But, with few exceptions, the Army doesn't stop training exercises for colder temps or heat waves. Be sure to bring or acquire an assortment of personal field gear that can handle any situation, whether you're training with weapons in January or running an obstacle course in July. A wide range of uniforms and clothing is important to remain healthy and effective in the field from the cold nights of winter to the sweltering days of summer. If summer days are dangerously hot, service members will be notified of red or black flag conditions. During these days, outdoor training may be interrupted or postponed to avoid heat illness among personnel.

Virginia School Enrollment

To be enrolled in a Virginia school, a child must be at least 5 years old by Sept. 30 of the current school year. Registration typically requires a birth certificate or other proof of the child's age and the child's previous school records and immunization records. For details on Virginia's minimum vaccine requirements for students in grades K-12, visit the Virginia Department of Education website. Check with individual schools for additional requirements prior to enrollment.

Schools in Fort Belvoir

Elementary school-age children living on post can enroll and attend Fort Belvoir Primary School or Fort Belvoir Upper School, both part of Fairfax County Public Schools. There are special considerations for military families who are moving into Fairfax County. Reach out to your School Liaison Officer for help or find more information here about registration requirements and policies for new students. The on-post elementary schools at Fort Belvoir are convenient for military families and feed into other schools in the Fairfax County Public School district. Middle and high school students attend off-post schools, Whitman Middle School, and Mount Vernon High School.

Fort Belvoir Primary School enrolls roughly 900 pre-K through second grade students every year. The primary school was constructed after the district was awarded a grant in 2014. It was built on the same campus where Fort Belvoir Upper School sits. It is one of four paired schools in Fairfax County Public Schools. The facility is equipped with the latest technologies to help immerse students in the digital age. The campus has a STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math) Lab, a science center, and a STEAM resource teacher to provide hands-on lessons to all students.

2. Fort Belvoir Upper School

Fort Belvoir Upper School enrolls roughly 500 fourth through sixth grade students every year. The original elementary school on Fort Belvoir opened its doors in 1998. It replaced three former elementary schools on the installation. The school was modified after the Fort Belvoir Primary School was constructed. and now the two schools sit side by side on a single campus. The Upper School is known for its technology offerings, as well as the musical programs it has to support budding musicians.

Student leadership is nurtured through safety patrols, student council, peer mediators, and inhour morning shows at both schools.

Fairfax County Public Schools has plenty of choices for its nearly 188,000 students living in Fairfax County. The district is the 10th largest school division in the U.S., with 198 schools and centers split up into five regions. This enormous district doesn't leave children behind though. Academics are at the root of everything; parents regularly relocate to the area to take advantage of the quality education their children can expect at a Fairfax County Public School. Over 90 percent of students graduate on time, and around the same number plan to pursue post-secondary education. Students have the option of taking Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate classes in high school. Many students have ties to nearby Fort Belvoir so the district offers military transition services to make things as easy as possible for transferring students.


